Catechism Corner

WSC Q. 65. What is forbidden in the fifth commandment?

A. The fifth commandment forbiddeth the neglecting of, or doing anything against, the honor and duty which belongeth to everyone in their several places and relations.

There are many ways to break the commandment to honor father and mother short of open rebellion. We have many ways to work against the authorities God has appointed. Sometimes we dishonor through not treating with proper respect. Sometimes through being apparently respectful, but then engaging in gossip that serves to undermine the very authorities we pretend to honor. Sometimes we outwardly indicate our compliance, but then through our less than whole -hearted adherence we help sabotage the effort (especially through passive-aggressive behavior). God forbids all of this in the fifth commandment.
