WSC Q. 91. How do the sacraments become effectual means of salvation?

A. The sacraments become effectual means of salvation, not from any virtue in them, or in him that doth administer them; but only by the blessing of Christ, and the working of his Spirit in them that by faith receive them.

The sacraments (Baptism and the Lord's Supper) "work." But they don't work by magic! They are outward signs of an inward work of grace. The Holy Spirit applies the sacraments to our hearts and minds, inwardly working spiritually to accomplish the thing signified physically. Their effectiveness is not tied to the one who ministers them (even a sinful pastor legitimately administers the sacraments – good news!). They are, however, tied to faith. They do no good (though they can do harm!) to non-believers.
