#### WSC Q. 93. Which are the sacraments of the New Testament?

A. The sacraments of the New Testament are, Baptism, and the Lord's Supper.

In Roman Catholicism there are seven sacraments, but we Protestants recognize only two. This is because we only recognize as sacraments those that Christ himself commanded for the Church as ongoing signs of his atoning work. He gave us a command to baptize (Matthew 28:18-20) and also to celebrate the Lord's Supper (Luke 22:19). None of the other rites recognized by some as sacraments have this mandate from Christ. Some are for only some people (like Holy Orders), while others are ordinances that are for all people rather than for the church (like Holy Matrimony).
