WSC Q. 48. What are we specially taught by these words before me in the first commandment?

A. These words before me in the first commandment teach us, that God, who seeth all things, taketh notice of, and is much displeased with, the sin of having any other god.

When God says “You will have no other gods before me” he doesn’t mean “You can have other gods as long as I’m your first god.” The word “before” in “before me” means “in front of.” And since God sees everything, what he means is “You shall have no other gods. Period.” In other words, “I’m it! Worship and serve me alone!”
