WSC Q. 52. What are the reasons annexed to the second commandment?

A. The reasons annexed to the second commandment are, God's sovereignty over us, his propriety in us, and the zeal he hath to his own worship.

Why does God give us this commandment not to worship idols? In part, It is due to his character as a jealous God. God will not (and, indeed, can not) share his glory with any other. He alone is God, and he is zealous for his own worship. He knows what we are made for and where we will find our joy – in him alone. For his sake and ours he refuses to allow us to pursue the worship of lesser things.
