WSC Q. 53. Which is the third commandment?

A. The third commandment is, Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain: for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

If we were making our own list of the ten most important moral imperatives for human flourishing, how many of us would include a commandment like this? No murder, stealing, and adultery makes sense – but taking the name of the Lord “in vain”? What does that even mean? The catechism will help us understand the meaning as we move forward, but it is enough to point out at this time that this is something that is very important to the Lord! We might not think this sounds like a big deal, but God certainly does! And he's the one issuing the imperatives....
